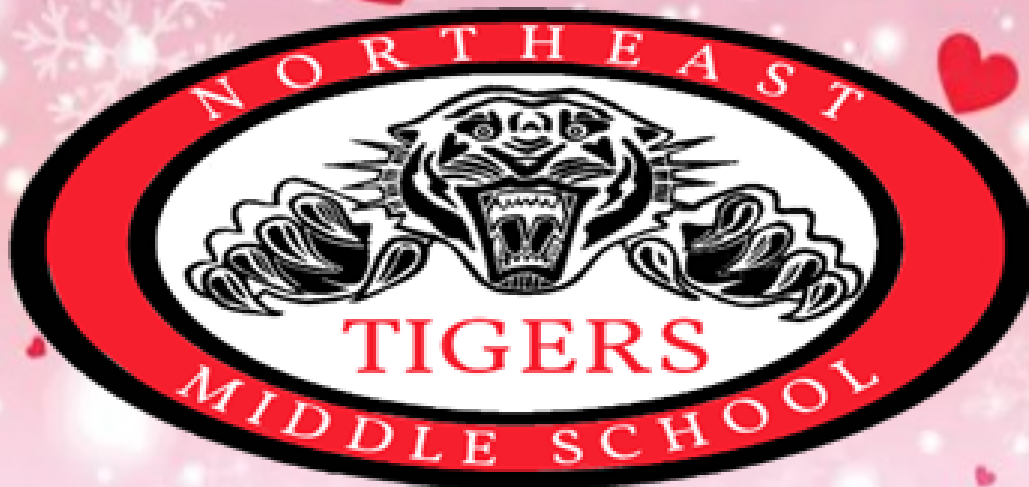

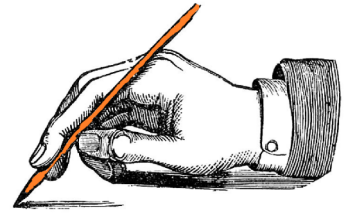

Attention 8th Grade Parents and Guardians:

In January, Bristol Eastern High School counselors came to NEMS to talk to 8th graders about the transition to 9th grade and the class choices available in high school. In early February, Mr. Carroll and Mrs. Bronson will be going into classes to walk all students through the process of picking their 2.5 credits of electives. Please review the 9th grade elective class choices at BEHS and BAIMS and the high school information handed out to students - which is also available on Mrs. Bronson's Google Classroom - and talk to your student about their class choices for 9th grade. The course selection is done through their Student Portal on Power School so parents/guardians will be able to see what their student has chosen, and changes will be able to be made for a short time afterwards if necessary. We also would like to welcome our new practicum student - Mr. Cassin - who is studying to be a school counselor and will be here on Thursdays to work with our great NEMS students.
